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Instructions for using T.A.S.C.O/Rittel's ProPlus Oil

ProPlus Oil is anionic, bisulfite natural oil. It is exceptional odorless oil for deep penetration and softness. It is considered all-purpose oil, excellent for rugs, garments and taxidermy work. It is extremely stable in heat and will not discolor.

We recommend that ProPlus oil be applied after your skins are tanned, rinsed, and drained. To use ProPlus oil, pour 1 part oil into 2 parts hot tap water. **Do not use boiling water!** The oil mixes best with water between 120-160 degrees Fahrenheit. Use a paint brush or sponge to apply the oil/water mixture.

After oiling, fold the skin much like folding a towel, and set it aside for 3-4 hours of sweating. Place it in a warm area. After this sweating period, unfold and hang to dry.

Do not dispose your oil/water mixture after its use. Seal it, and simply reheat and apply it for reuse on your next batch of tanned skins or capes.
