## Instructions for using Relaxer/Washer/Degreaser (RD-601)

**<u>Relaxer Usage</u>**: To prepare a relaxing solution: Mix 1 Oz. of RD-601 to every 1 Gallon of lukewarm water used. Use enough water to completely submerge the skins. Work the skins as they soak – this will hasten the softening process. Do not over soak the skins. When the skins have become soft and flexible, they are ready to remove for fleshing or pickling, after rinsing.

**Washing Usage**: To prepare a washing solution: Mix 1 Oz. of RD-601 to every 1 gallon of water. Use this solution to wash the flesh, fur, wool or hair, free of all dirt, grime and debris. Do not soak the skins, but clean them thoroughly. If they are unusually dirty, use another fresh solution. After washing, rinse the skins in several changes of fresh water.

**Degreaser Usage**: To prepare degreasing solution: Mix 2 Oz. of RD -601 to every 1 gallon of water. After placing the skins into this degreasing solution, plunge them up and down, and work them with your hands. This will help work the oil and grease out of the skin. When degreased, rinse the skin in several changes of fresh water.

> *Note*: 3 level Tablespoons of RD-601 = 1 Oz. of RD-601 (by weight)
